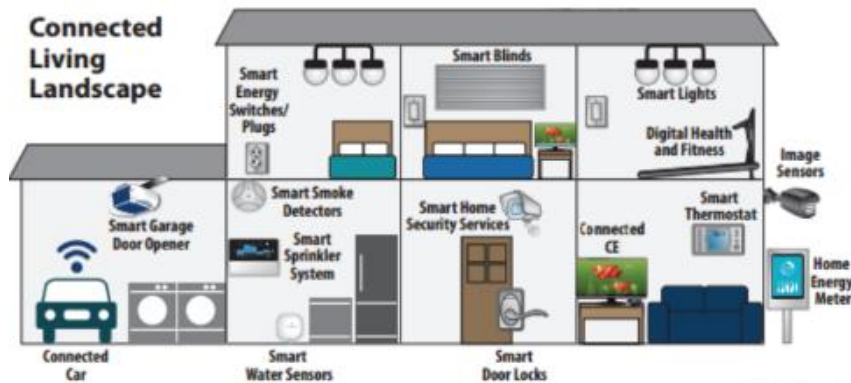


# If it's Connected, it needs to be Protected!
